

Directions from the Northwest

Leaving Knoxville on I-40, driving time will be just under two hours. After entering North Carolina and passing the Welcome Center, you will exit at exit #15, Fines Creek; turn left at the bottom of the ramp. You will go approximately 5 miles (this is a guess), passing the Fines Creek Community Center, an old stone building on your left. Shortly after this, you will come to a stop sign; turn right and proceed over the new bridge for about 1/2 mile to the intersection of 209; this is located at a small gas station/store called Ferguson Supply, turn left here. (209 also goes straight toward Lake Junaluska).

After turning left, you will go 11 miles over Betsy's Gap. Please remember to put your vehicle in a lower gear so you do not have to be on the brakes all the time when coming down the mountain. You will pass Luck, NC, and you will be near Trust, NC. At the corner just past the Spring Creek General Store and Cafe on your right, you will turn a sharp right onto Hwy 63. We are 2 miles down on Hwy 63. You will see our sign, Briar Rose Farm, on the highway just after the left turn onto Duckett Top Tower Road.

The Sweet Briar Cabin is located 1/2 mile up Duckett Top Tower Road. Turn to your left through the rusted orange gate before crossing the creek and proceed up to the cabin. Look for the small address sign #489. While you are at the cabin, we want you to feel it is your private place. We generally love to meet and get to know our guests and their families, but for those of you that want complete privacy, we want to assure you that we will not be over without you inviting or expecting us. We do like to keep an eye on the PH balance and cleanliness of the hot tubs, but will generally let you know when we will be up to check them. We are looking forward to meeting you and will do what we can to make your visit to the mountains all that you hope it to be.
