

## Directions from the South

As you drive on I-26 and get close to Asheville, you will come to a three way split. This occurs at exits 31A and B. The first sign to the right says Hickory, the middle one says Asheville and that is the one you want. This will take you in a circle around Asheville first going north, then east; you will be on I -240 East.

As you pass the first few exits, get into the left lane and stay there looking for 19/23 South. This will be Exit 3A. (Yes, you will be going WEST on 19/23 South, go figure!) Stay in the left hand lane as you cross the bridge. You then have about 5 stoplights to get over to the right hand lane. You will be looking for Highway 63, otherwise known as New Leicester Highway. There is a large Ingles Grocery at the stoplight at this intersection, which only comes in from the right (there is one more large Ingles Grocery between here and the farm, but no other large food stores beyond that). Turn here and go about 27 miles on Highway 63; this will take you to the top of Doggett Mountain.

If you reset your odometer at the top, we are 3 miles on the other side, right off of Highway 63. Please remember to put your vehicle in a lower gear so you do not have to be on the brakes all the time when coming down the mountain. You will see our sign, Briar Rose Farm, on the highway just before the right turn onto Duckett Top Tower Road.

The Sweet Briar Cabin is located 1/2 mile up Duckett Top Tower Road. Turn to your left through the rusted orange gate before crossing the creek and proceed up to the cabin. Look for the small address sign #489.

While you are at the cabin, we want you to feel it is your private place. We generally love to meet and get to know our guests and their families, but for those of you that want complete privacy, we want to assure you that we will not be over without you inviting or expecting us. We do like to keep an eye on the PH balance and cleanliness of the hot tubs, but will generally let you know when we will be up to check them. We are looking forward to meeting you and will do what we can to make your visit to the mountains all that you hope it to be.
